## LES AGASSES IGP MEDITERRANÉE 2021 CHÂTEAU VAL JOANIS

Producing wines since Roman times, today the estate is owned by the Roozen family, who are continually striving to produce delicious wine, whilst protecting their environment.

Val Joanis is a beautiful estate of 400 hectares with stunning gardens and views over the Lubéron.

The 120 hectares of vineyard spread over the hills at altitudes ranging from 280m to 450m, the site of the famous plot 'Les Griottes'. The vineyards also benefit from a sunny exposure and enjoy a particularly favourable microclimate with late ripening giving the wines freshness and balance.

Les Agasses is a fresh and balanced rosé with a combination of red fruit and citrus.

**Grape:** Syrah, Grenache, Gamay, Vermentino

### **Vineyard & Vinification Note:**

From a vineyard environmentally certified HVE3

This wine comes from plots in altitudes exposed West and-South-West.

**Altitude:** Between 200 and 400 metres

**Soil:** Clay-limestone **Yield:** 55hl/hectare

**Vinification:** Direct pressing, low temperature fermentation in stainless steel vats.

**Tasting Note:** Pale pink with delicate grenadine reflections.

The nose reveals a subtle blend of citrus fruits and flowers.

The palate is fresh and crunchy with notes of currant and citrus. A beautiful harmony between smoothness and vivacity.

**Food pairing:** Beautiful aperitif. It pairs well with asparagus, artichokes, chicken, crab cakes and seafood. It is also a great accompaniment to Provençal food, anchovies, grilled sardines, and tapenade.

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
