VAL JO -LE ROUGE IGP MEDITERRANÉE 2020 CHÂTEAU VAL JOANIS

Producing wines since Roman times, today the estate is owned by the Roozen family, who are continually striving to produce delicious wine, whilst protecting their environment.

Val Joanis is a beautiful estate of 400 hectares with stunning gardens and views over the Lubéron.

The 120 hectares of vineyard spread over the hills at altitudes ranging from 280m to 450m, the site of the famous plot 'Les Griottes'. The vineyards also benefit from a sunny exposure and enjoy a particularly favourable microclimate with late ripening giving the wines freshness and balance.

Val Jo Le Rouge is very supple, fruity with a gorgeous fresh finish.

Grape: Syrah, Grenache and Marselan.

Vineyard & Vinification Note:

From a vineyard environmentally certified HVE3

Val Jo Le Rouge comes from vineyards on hillsides facing south and south-west with soils of limestone, red clay and pebbles.

Vinification: Cold maceration to preserve freshness. Very brief fermentation.

Tasting Note:

The colour is aubergine with purple reflections. The spicy nose reveals notes of plums and black cherries. On the palate, the material is unctuous, supple with aromas of well-ripened red fruits.

Food pairing: A great partner to poultry, red meat and cheeses.



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
